

**Activities and Achievements of Technical Education Department, Haryana,
Panchkula
2017-18**

1.Introduction

At the time of inception of Haryana state in 1966, there were only 6 Polytechnics (Govt. 4 & Govt. Aided-2) and one Regional Engineering College at Kurukshetra (a joint venture of State Govt. and Govt. of India) with student intake 1341 only. Now the Department has established 4 State Technical Universities. Besides this 504 Technical Institutes are also running with an intake capacity of 122649.

Activities: The Department designs need based programmes for Diploma, Under-graduate and Post-graduate level courses to provide adequate human resources. It also provides infrastructure for imparting requisite technical skills in the field of Engineering and Technology, Architecture and Urban Planning, Management, Pharmacy, Hotel Management, Fine Arts, Applied Arts & Crafts and Design. The Department assigns high priority to meet educational needs of deprived sections of society such as Scheduled Castes, Women, Physically Challenged Persons, rural population and other socio-economically and educationally backward classes. It also runs an objective evaluation and certification system for students, courses and institutions. The Department also provides career counseling to students and helps them in proper placement for gainful employment. Job fairs are held in collaboration with The Confederation of Indian Industry (Northern Region), PHD Chamber of Commerce Industry, District Industries Associations and other Industry & Trade Associations.

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3. The following National Institutes are being established in the State:-

- i. **Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT)** is being established at village Kilohrad, district Sonapat for which 50 acres of land has been provided free of cost by the Gram Panchayat. Guest classes of IIIT have been started in the campus of NIT Kurukshetra from 2014-15.
- ii. **Indian Institute of Management, Rohtak** is being established at Rohtak over 200 acres of land. It is presently running in the temporary campus at MDU, Rohtak.
- iii. **National Institute of Design (NID)** is being established at Umri, district Kurukshetra over a plot of 20.5 acres of land. The guest classes of NID Kurukshetra have, in the meantime, been started in the campus of Govt. Polytechnic umri, Kurukshetra w.e.f 15.11.2016.
- iv. **National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT)** is being established in Sector-23 Panchkula over a 10.45- acre plot. The foundation stone of the NIFT was laid by Hon'ble Union Textile Minister and Hon'ble Chief Minister on 29-12-2016.
- v. **An Extension Campus (Faculty Development) of the IIT Delhi** is being established at the Rajiv Gandhi Education City, Kundli, district Sonapat in 50 acres of land. There is a proposal for establishing Science & Technology Park, High Performance Computing Facility and Faculty Development Centre in the campus.
- vi. **Another Extension Campus (Research and Development) of IIT Delhi** is being set up at Village Badhsa District Jhajjar on 50 acres of land. There is a proposal for establishing Skill Development Centre and Bio-Sciences Research Park in the campus. IIT, Delhi is working out further modalities.
- vii. **Technology Centre of Ministry of Small, Micro and Medium Enterprises, Govt. of India** is being set up in the premises of Govt. Polytechnic Neemka, Distt. Faridabad. The State Govt. has provided entire building of Govt. Polytechnic, Neemka (Faridabad) with a built-up area measuring 87,300 sq. ft. to The National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) for setting up of a Technology Centre at Faridabad.
- viii. **National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology Centre** is being setup at Kurukshetra as per announcement made by Hon'ble Union Minister for Communication

&Information Technology, GoI on 27.2.2016. The centre will temporarily function in the building of Govt. Polytechnic, Umri (Kurukshetra). Another NIEIT Centre is being established in the premises of Govt. Polytechnic, Manesar (Gurugram).

- ix. **Plastic Satellite Centre of Central Institute of Plastic Engineering & Technology (CIPET)** is being setup in Karnal as per announcement made by Hon'ble Union Minister for Chemical & Fertilizers, Govt. of India on 03.06.2016. The Deputy commissioner Karnal has been requested to identify a suitable building for the proposed centre.

4. State Institutes of Engineering & Technology:

- i) **Sh. Ranbir Singh State Institute of Engineering & Technology** is being established at village SilaniKesho in Jhajjar district in the 40 acre land. The classes are likely to be started from the academic session 2017-18 with the due approval of AICTE.
- ii) **Rao Birender Singh State Institute of Engineering & Technology** is being established at village Zainabad in district Rewari in the 52.50 acre land. The classes are likely to be started from the academic Session 2017-18 with due approval of AICTE.
- iii) **Government Engineering College, Nilokheri** has been setup in the campus of Govt. Polytechnic, Nilokheri; district Karnal from the academic session 2016-17 with the approval of AICTE.
- iv) **Government Polytechnics:** The construction work of two Govt. Polytechnics at Neemka (Faridabad) and Shergarh (Kaithal) has been completed, while five new Government Polytechnics at Indri (Nuh), Malab (Nuh), Chhappar (Bhiwani), JamalpurShekhan (Fatehabad) and Mandkola (Palwal) are on completion stage.
- v) Two New Govt. Polytechnics-cum-Multi Skill Development Centres are being setup at Sector-26, Panchkula and village Dhamlawas, district Rewari.

5. Projects funded by Central Govt.:

- i) The Government of India has sanctioned seven Polytechnics in unserved /underserved districts for which grant of Rs. 12.30 crore of each Polytechnic is being provided by the MHRD, GoI.
- ii) The construction work of Hathnikund (Yamuna Nagar), Umri (Kurukshetra), Jattal (Panipat) and Dhangar (Fatehabad) polytechnics has been completed and construction work of Govt. Polytechnic Nanakpur (Panchkula) is in progress.

- iii) Besides this, Govt. Polytechnic at Sadhaura, district Yamuna Nagar under the scheme - Multi Sectoral Development Programme of Ministry of Minority Affairs, GoI is also being set up.

6. New Initiatives for Skill Development in the State are as under:

- i) Haryana Skill Development Mission (HSDM) registered in the society mode and formally launched by Hon'ble Chief Minister on 14.07.2015. Mission is providing skill training to the youth of Haryana for wage and self employment.
- ii) A MoU has been signed between HSDM and United Nation Development Program (UNDP) on 14.07.2015 to leverage the needs for skilled personnel and to create opportunity for the skill development, employment and entrepreneurship for women in NCR region of Haryana.
- iii) Under integrated skill development schemes (ISDS) of Ministry of Textile, GoI, Department has a target to train 20,000 persons in seven districts in 2015-16 & 2016-17.

7. Projects/Programme running under SwarnJayanti Scheme.

i) Vishwakarma Skill University.

The Vishwakarma Skill University Bill 2016 has been passed by the Haryana Vidhan Sabha on 30-08-2016. The Vishwakarma Skill University Act has been notified vide Haryana Gazette notification no. Leg. 29/2016 dated 20.09.2016. 67 posts have been created by the Finance Department for Vishwakarma Skill University. Vice Chancellor of Vishwakarma Skill University has been appointed by the Government.

Note- Council of Minister's has decided in its meeting held on 03.01.2017 that the work of Skill Development Mission and Vishwakarma Skill Development University were transferred to Industrial Training and Vocational Education, Department (ITI Deptt.).

ii) Accreditation of Govt. Polytechnics:

A programme has been approved as a SwarnJayanti Project in order to effectively meet the eligibility requirements of NBA accreditation. Total funds of Rs. 115 crore shall be provided for the accreditation project to be completed over 4 years.
