No. 6/4/2022-1 Cabinet.— In exercise of the powers conferred under clauses (2) and (3) of article 166 of the Constitution of India, I, Bandaru Dattatraya, Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Business of the Haryana Government (Allocation) Rules, 1974, namely:-
