Guidelines for disbursement of SC Scholarship under Post Matric Scholarship Scheme

of Govt. of India

Previous Guidelines issued vide Memo No. 796-1436 dated 07.9.2012 on the above cited subject are hereby amended with the approval of competent authority as under:

Sr.	Guideline	Applicability

1	Post Matric Scholarship benefit will be given to SC students admitted through Centralized counseling as well as at institute level. However, SC scholarship under PMS Scheme shall be limited to 40% of the <u>sanctioned intake</u> of the Institutions. Selection shall be on the basis of merit of prescribed entrance exam and then on the basis of merit of qualifying exam.	Session 2011-12 admissions onwards
	<u>Under Lateral Entry</u> , the students admitted directly in the 2 nd year against, a) 20% of intake of previous year; and	
	b) dropout of any SC student, who was covered under 40% seats of PMS Scheme on merit basis in the first year, shall also be over and above the 40% limit and selection will be on merit basis as above.	
2	Payment of scholarship shall be made directly to the students through online transfer to the students' saving account to be opened in the nationalized bank having ECS / CBS facility and if online transfer is not feasible, payment be made through account payee cheque in the name of student.	Session 2010-11 onwards
3	The reimbursement of SC Scholarship under PMS to the eligible SC students shall be made semester-wise in two installments after submission/verification of relevant documents. SC students seeking Scholarship under the scheme must ensure minimum of 70% attendance in the semester concerned. If any malpractice is observed / reported, biometric attendance shall be made compulsory in the institute.	Session 2010-11 onwards
4	Book bank facility, maintenance allowance, study tours etc. as contained in PMS scheme shall be provided to the eligible SC students.	Session 2011-12 onwards
5	As per Clause (iv) of Section 7 of Post Matric Scholarship Scheme of GOI for the students belonging to Scheduled Castes, if according to regulations of a University / Institution, a student is promoted to the next higher class even though he / she may not have actually passed in lowe class and is required to take examination of the junior class again after some time, he / she will be entitled to Post Matric Scholarship for the class to which he / she is promoted if the student is otherwise eligible for scholarship.	
6	As per the provision of PMS scheme, Income certificate is required to be taken once only i.e. at the time of admission to courses which are continuing for more than one year. a) Employed parents/guardians: Income certificate from their employer and for any	

additional income from other sources, they would furnish self-declaration / undertaking.

b) Self-employed parents/guardians: An income declaration stating definite income from all sources by way of self-declaration / undertaking.

Note: As per Chief Secretary letter No. 62/09/2010-6GS1 dt 31.12.2013, directions have been issued regarding replacement of affidavit by self declaration / undertaking that the facts stated in the application are correct to the best of his or her knowledge & belief and that nothing has been concealed therein. In case of concealment or misrepresentation, legal action would be taken against the culprits under Section 182, Section 415 read with Section 417 and Section 420 of Indian Penal Court as the case may be.

Intensive checking / inspections shall be made by the respective Disbursing Institutes of the Department during the conduct of session. Only after verifying the records of the admitted SC students, minimum attendance (70%), physical presence of the SC students in at least one theory paper of semester examination, the claim shall be settled & scholarship released accordingly in time bound manner.
