Marathawada Mitra Mandal's College of Architecture, Pune. Maharashtra filed a Writ Petition No. 5004 of 2007 in the High Court of Bombay challenging the COA's action. The Hon'ble High Court in its interim order dated 03-12-2007 stayed the advertisement issued by the Council on 18-05-2007 in this regard. The COA has challenged this interim order of 03-12-2007 of the High Court of Bombay by filing SLP No. 3964 of 2008 in the Supreme Court. In the meantime the Registrar, COA again issued a public notice on 12-03-2008 making NATA compulsory for admission to B.Arch. Course. The Apex Court passed an interim order on 24-07-2008 staying the operation of the public notice issued by the Council of Architecture and clarified that CBSE or any State Government much less the Government of Maharashtra or any Institution may conduct competitive test for admission in B.Arch. Course and the students may be admitted on the basis of result of such tests. The Hon'ble Supreme Court further held that it would not be necessary for the students to pass NATA for which Council of Architecture is insisting. The interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the State of Maharashtra with the complaint that after passing of the interim order dated 29th February, 2008, by this court, the Registrar, Council or Architecture, has issued public notice dated 12th March, 2008, to the effect that no institution of the country shall make admission in Bachelor of Architecture course unless a candidate had passed out National Aptitude Test in Architecture [for short 'NATA']. Thereafter he issued communication to the Director, Technical Education, Maharashtra, to the same effect.

Having heard the parties at length, we feel. that the matter requires serious consideration and the hearing may take some more time. However, "as some doubts have been created in the mind of student community throughout the country as to whether they should appear in the examination conducted by different State Governments or by Central Board of Secondary Education [for short, 'C.B.S.E.'] or by any other Institution or they must clear NATA for admission in Bachelor of Architecture course, it is necessary to clarify the position. Accordingly, we modify interim order dated 29th February, 2008, to this extent that C.B.S.E., any State Government, much less the Government of Maharashtra or any other Institution may conduct competitive test for admission in Bachelor of Architecture course and the students may be admitted on the basis of the result of such tests and the courses may commence thereafter. It will not be necessary for the students to pass NATA for which the Council of Architecture is insisting." However, this order will be subject to the result of the special leave petition.


During the pendency of this case, operation of public notice issued by the Council of Architecture on 12th March, 2008, shall remain stayed.
